A 10-year-old boy presented with pain abdomen and non-bilious vomiting for 6 months, progressively enlarging mass in the epigastrium for 20 days and hematemesis 4 days back. Relevant lab investigations showed moderate anemia, thrombocytosis, hypoproteinemia, hypoalbuminemia, and high lactate dehydrogenase. Bone marrow examination was normal. A contrast-enhanced computed tomography of the abdomen was performed.
